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DIRECTORS NOTE

This year marks the 250th anniversary of the birth of one of our great authors, Jane Austen! She only wrote six books in her life... And her last one, Persuasion, was actually published by her brother, six months after she passed away. Many critics and fans alike regard Persuasion as her finest work. It is a story of lost love and second chances. I'm not the only one who wonders if this piece isn't semi-autobiographical. We don't know much about Jane's personal life... Not her love life anyway, excepting she never married. Anne Elliot's character says, "All I will claim for my own sex is that of loving longest when all hope is gone." It does make you wonder if the words Jane wrote for our heroine, Anne Elliot, was not an echo of own personal love life. Did Jane Austen have a secret love? That is a mystery we will probably never solve! The detective in me would love to know... But the friend in me is glad that her personal life has remained her own.

I would like to thank this wonderful cast who have gone far and beyond to tell you this wonderful story with depth and grace. Thank you to Rebecca for her beautiful costumes and to Erin for her thoughtful props. I think the set and lighting is some of the most beautiful my brother Jim has ever designed. He's kind of a genius. The beautiful music for the sound design was all chosen by my son, Spencer. He's kind of a genius as well. My daughter-in-law, Kaitlyn, wanted to try her hand at script writing... her adaptation of Persuasion is the result... I think she's a genius too.

Can't do any of this without two wonderful men in my life — my right hand, man, Seth Larson, the production assistant, and my dear husband, Michael, who, in addition to playing the Admiral so admirably and moving set pieces, has to live with me while I'm directing it! Add two more geniuses to the list! Lastly, I'd like to thank my mom for her words of encouragement, and of course to Jane Austen, whom I consider a personal friend.

I hope someday that Jane and I can walk in a heavenly country garden somewhere talk about our families and remark, while laughing arm and arm, on the shrubberies. Happy birthday, my friend! XO.

SUMMARY

Jane Austen's *Persuasion* unfolds amidst the elegant society of early 19th-century England. Anne Elliot, a thoughtful and reserved young woman, finds herself at a crossroads when Captain Frederick Wentworth, a former suitor whom she was persuaded to reject years ago, reenters her life as a wealthy and successful naval officer. Set against the backdrop of societal expectations and personal regrets, "*Persuasion*" explores themes of love, regret, and second chances.

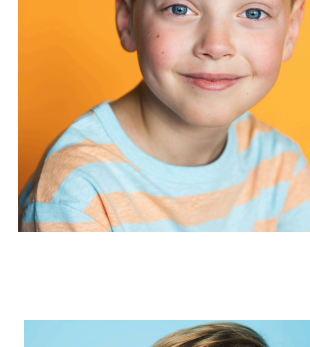


NURSE ROOK

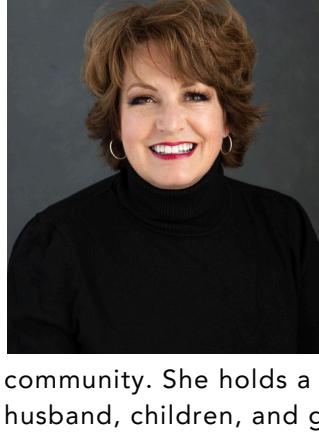

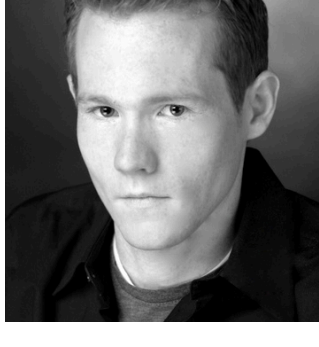
DIRECTOR

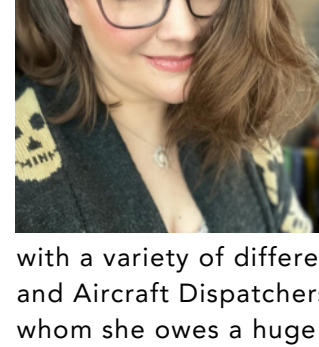
SET & LIGHTING DESIGN

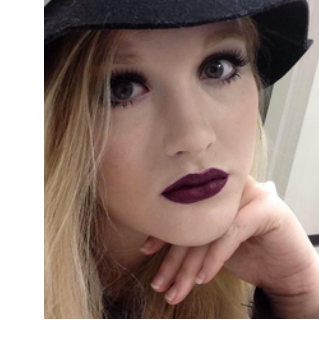
PROPERTIES
